



Whale testicle beer and fecal wine

Sweden is home to several [off-the-beaten-track museums](#), but the Disgusting Food Museum in Malmö broke new ground last month when it launched an exhibition of [some of the world's weirdest alcohol](#), popular science website LiveScience reported. To be featured in the exhibit, a drink "had to be considered drinkable somewhere in the world." The drinks on display included a Korean medicinal rice wine brewed with human feces, an Icelandic beer [brewed with smoked whale testicles](#), a sample of the [world's strongest beer](#) served inside a taxidermied squirrel, English gin flavoured with nettle and ants, and chicha, an ancient Peruvian corn beer with [a brewing process that involves spit](#). Although there's no tasting component to the exhibit, curator Andreas Ahrens did try a sample of almost everything. "The only one I can't bring myself to trying is the poo wine," Ahrens told LiveScience. "It's just messing with my head."
