Reporting Questions

yes/no questions

→ WORD ORDER: reporting verb + if/whether + subject + verb

"Is <u>she</u> ready?"
→ question word order: VERB + SUBJECT ...

He asked me **if she was** ready. →statement word order: **SUBJECT + VERB ...** .

→Questions with the auxiliary "to do"

a) "Does she like me?" (present simple) \lor b) "Did Cindy see me?" (past simple) \lor He asked me if she liked him. (past simple) He asked me if Cindy had seen him. (past perfect)

Note: since this is no longer a question we don't need the auxiliary verb TO DO!

wh-questions

→ WORD ORDER: reporting verb + question-word + subject + verb

"When is she coming?" → question word order: VERB + SUBJECT ...

He asked me when she was coming. →statement word order: SUBJECT + VERB

What did the policeman ask you yesterday? Report his questions. Example: 1) The policeman asked me where I had been the night before/the previous night.
